APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY MINUTES

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- **Waste Transfer Site**

Cllr Coetzee is going to get clarification about the fact that you can dump once a month without a permit as from 1st July 2013. We are not sure if this applies to our Waste Drop Off Site. At present dumping tickets can still be obtained from the Municipal office. The Board still has to be moved. Steve and Jason went around the village after the Easter weekend and took photos of the waste bags left on the street after the collection day. Dogs and Bag diggers had gone through them with litter all over the place. No direct policing has taken place or fines issued to residents who break the law by doing this. As residents often use the neighbours basket for their rubbish one could end up fining the wrong person. Cllr Coetzee will ask for information in this regard to be placed in the bulletin that goes out with the accounts

- **One Way Law Street**

Problems are still being encountered with vehicles deliberately being driven in the wrong direction in the one way street. Staff of the Pearly's Pub being one of the culprits. Mr Blankenberg will be asked to address the Owner of Pearly's Pub and Grill

about the Patrons breaking the law.

- **OPENING OF THE HERBARIUM AND FIRST AID ROOM**

The opening went well. Everyone was impressed with the Mayor's speech.

- **USE OF VIBRATING ROAD ROLLER AT PEARLY BEACH**

Jason reported that Mr Crafford said that the vibrator was not being used and if at any point it is switched on to let him know and he will make that they turn it off again.

VILLAGE GREEN

We are looking at having the first market day on the green at the beginning of summer either in September or October. There will be strict control of the type of stalls that will be allowed.

Heilie has indicated that she will see to it that the trees get watered.

We will put a wheel rim on the wall for the hosepipe to be locked onto.

CONSERVANCY

Jason reported that they are busy putting together information about the plants in the Herbarium so that not just the name of the plant is put next to the specimen but also a bit of info about the plant. The suggestion was made that they contact the Pringle Bay Conservancy and Fernkloof in Hermanus. Steve is busy with new posters for the Herbarium and will discuss these with Jason. It was suggested that we get a proper road sign made by the Municipality indicating the location of Herbarium. He asked that the fundraising request be removed from the Website. Jason undertook to follow up about the tortoise sign.

GENERAL

Nelia clarified the wording of the new plot clearing policy as the one she had still mentioned the use of the “bossieslaner”

Cllr Coetzee gave a brief outline of the new Budget of specific items that concern the Ratepayers.
