Shirley welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked Steve for hosting the meeting at The Ark at such short notice. Cllr Coetzee opened the meeting in prayer.

APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY MINUTES

Nelia advised that she had also attended the meeting with Johan van Taak. The minutes were then amended accordingly and thereafter their acceptance was proposed by Steve and seconded by Nelia.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

♣ Waste Transfer Site

The notice board at the site still needs to be moved. Cllr Coetzee will liaise with the Municipality in this regard.

Jason suggested that more stringent measures be adopted against those householders who place household refuse in the street on days other than the day of collection. The committee agreed that a notice be delivered to each household that contravenes the regulations in an effort to curb this practice. The law enforcement officer would also be requested to patrol the village on a Tuesday, possibly after the Easter weekend to address the problem. Appropriate fines could then also be implemented as a deterrent.

♣ One Way Law Street

Problems are still being encountered with vehicles deliberately being driven in the wrong direction in the one way street. Action will need to be taken by the traffic department.

I AND FIRST AID ROOM

Good progress has been made with regard to the completion of the village green. Olive trees have been planted. Jason advised that he has applied for fynbos signage. The possibility of moving the village notice board to the site of the new Herbarium was also considered.

The official opening of the Herbarium and First Aid Room will take place on Thursday, 14 March at 1 pm. Ilse Keet is liaising with the OK Bazaars for donations of food and juice for the event. Robin, Susan and Shirley have also agreed to provide light refreshments for the occasion. Cllr Coetzee will collect tables from the community hall in Eluxolweni on Wednesday and glasses and plates will be supplied by the municipality. Shirley suggested that the municipality be asked to donate suitable ribbon for the opening ceremony. Cllr Coetzee also agreed to contact Francois de Jongh at the Courant and Steve was requested to prepare a press release and to also take some photographs for posting on the website.

USE OF VIBRATING ROAD ROLLER AT PEARLY BEACH

Jason reported that Dave & Yvonne Foord have also expressed their concern regarding the use of the vibrating road roller at Pearly Beach. It was recommended that the Foords be invited to rejoin the Ratepayers' Association. Cllr Coetzee suggested that Jason contact Dirk Crafford in this regard as it is possible for the vibrator to be switched off when the roller is in use. He also suggested that Theo raise this matter at the Ward committee meeting on Thursday.

FIREWATCH PROGRESS REPORT

Cllr Coetzee advised the committee that there is a new fire chief and that Theo will have to re-negotiate with him as there is now also a problem with the building and the trailer.
